2. Pay 1st month tuition & \$15 registration fee per student. This action secures a place for your student, non-refundable. You'll receive a secure pay portal via e-mail within one week of your registration to pay online.

Auditions

Everyone is guaranteed a role. Auditions for role placement will occur on the 2nd rehearsal. The show is a commitment, regardless of role placement. We will announce casting on the 3rd rehearsal. (Roles of Willy Wonka, Charlie, and others will be open to any gender.)

Class Attendance:

We do expect students to attend rehearsal. If your child is sick, please e-mail us as soon as possible. If your child has a conflict, please write it on the "conflict calendar" found on the bulletin board in the lobby. Last minute conflicts are not conducive to a productive team. If the student is not at rehearsal it is possible they may not be in the number worked on that day. This is not a punishment in any way, simply a fact of the system.

What are the costs?

1. **Tuition** is broken down into monthly installments of **\$120.00**. We offer a 30% discount for any additional sibling making their cost **\$84.00**. Tuition is due on the 1st of every month Jan.-May. January tuition is included during registration. We will e-mail an invoice with a secure online pay portal each month. No refunds, credits, or discounts (excluding the sibling discount). We want to be fair to all of our families at ClevengerCreations. If you have a hardship, please come talk to us before tuition is due. Accounts must be up to date prior to opening night.
2. **Costume Fee:** \$75 Due: **Feb. 15th** an online invoice will be sent.
3. **Jazz Shoes:** Jazz shoes are required for this program. (Boys - Black, girls – we prefer tan; however, black or tan are acceptable.) These can be purchased in Jacksonville or online at Discount Dance (sometimes payless has them). Please do not wait to make this purchase, as soon as the student has jazz shoes please write their name inside & bring them to every rehearsal. Do not wear jazz shoes outside.
4. **Tickets:** will be sold Online Only beginning **Saturday March 7th 10am**. We cannot hold tickets. You can purchase tickets securely online, ticket+fee (\$10+fee) beginning **Saturday March 7th 10am**. Lap children 5 & under can sit in a parents' lap without a ticket. Please do not wait to purchase tickets, when we sell out we cannot legally add another seat per our contract with Music Theatre International. If tickets sell out- Devin & Elizabeth are not responsible for additional accommodations. The Royalties to legally perform this musical were purchased with the tickets sales from the previous musical

(Frozen Jr.) Please put an alarm reminder set for **Saturday March 7th 10am** on your phone.

5. **Make-Up, Hair, & Show Underclothes:** For 2nd dress rehearsal, students will need foundation & powder that matches their skin tone with a sponge. Girls will need false eyelashes w/ clear/white eyelash glue for dress rehearsals & shows, buy several high-quality sets (you can reuse them 2 to 3 times usually). No dollar tree, Elf, Wet n'Wild, products. Thick pairs, not "natural" eyelashes & no magnetic eyelashes. We will provide all other makeup needs. Every student will need to wear neutral form fitting clothing underneath their costume Ex: tank tops, leotards & tights, spandex shorts etc. Plain neutral colored clothing. Nude/skin colored is preferred for girls. Each student should bring their own hairbrush with their name written on it to the 2nd dress rehearsal & all shows. If you'd like to volunteer to do hair or make-up for your child's cast, please look out for bulletin board sign-ups in the lobby. It is best if the same people are available for the entire run. Volunteer parents are only needed prior to the show starting & not during the show itself.
6. **Non-Mandatory T-shirt:** We will use these shirts if we have a non-mandatory public performance (ex. Farmers market, arts market etc.) Date TBD. Show T-shirts are \$20. Shirt orders will be taken through the google form when registering for the production.
7. **Referral Incentive:** refer a friend, tell them to put your name on their initial registration form (they may only put 1 name). If they sign-up, pay for Jan. class, and attend 1st day of class, we will deduct \$15 from your February tuition. NO LIMIT! Available until class sizes are filled.

Baby Clevenger:

As many of our wonderful studio parents know, we will be expecting our baby the beginning of January.

1. Make-up for inevitable missed rehearsal in January due to Baby Clevenger: Saturday Feb. 29th A 9am-11am - B 12pm-2pm - C 3pm-5pm
2. Please check your e-mail prior to rehearsal during the month of January. We will communicate through e-mail & Facebook if Baby Clevenger decides to make his debut on a rehearsal day & there is not an available substitute teacher in place. (Doesn't he know how important rehearsal is to us?).
3. When dropping your child off at rehearsal, PLEASE make sure they are able to enter the building – we do not want any children left outside the studio unattended in the event of an emergency.
